We would like to inform you of an attendance incentive event held monthly for our scholars with 100% attendance. Especially during the pandemic and this virtual learning world, MESA wanted to recognize the scholars who are working hard on attendance and schoolwork. Every month, MESA scholars who achieve 100% attendance, either through attending synchronous (live) classes, and/or submitting work asynchronously (outside of live class time) each day, will be rewarded with a scheduled time to visit our Rewards Fun Center.
